

Here are a number of interesting match stick puzzles. We shall start with easy ones and go for big ones later.


1. The equation given below is wrong. Changing only one matchstick, get the equation corrected : 10 sec.







1. David Rice Atchison, President of the Senate pro tempore. President Polk's term ended on Sunday March 4th 1849 at noon. His vice President George Dallas resigned President of the Senate on March 2nd, 1849. President Zachary Taylor took his oath of office as President on Monday, March 5th, 1849. So, Atchison was the President for one day. Ethiopia, Guinea and Mali have exactly similar colors in their national flags, and so too the sequence of the colors. Ethiopia has red, yellow and green transversely face, Guinea, the above three colors in the same order but vertically, while Mali has green, yellow and red in sequence from left to right vertically.
3. Wall Street Journal is published by Dow Jones and Co, who are the 'tops' in Wall Street Stock Exchange. Wall Street Journal take pride in their delivery service to their customers - both or time and almost always 100% compliance ; They often quote one Mrs Patty Goldightly, who once completed her delivery on Friday, went to hospital to deliver her baby, and was back on her journal delivery on Monday ; Don't you think, that was far beyond the call of duty ; That is sincerity ;
4. Mayday is the international word for Emergency. 5. The Rose is the national flower of England, Iran, Honduras, Poland, Rumania and Czechoslovakia.
6. This may surprise you, but it is true that Leonardo de Vinci did a preliminary drawing in charcoal of Modonna Lisa, the person in the picture of Mora Lisa. This charcoal sketch, which is almost exactly like the Mona Lisa itself, except for colors, is in Conde Museum in (Chartilly, France.
7. If you watch the last words, you can make out Kola, and then perhaps you can guess the whole thing as "Pepsi Cola". This is in Russian; and Pepsi Cola is the first US consumer product for sale in USSR. Recently, Coke has entered the Russian market, and now both Coke and Pepsi Cola are entering all communist countries. Incidentally, Coke is monopolising China market, although both Coke and Pepsi Cola are available in Hong Kong ;
8. H M S Trinidad, the Royal Navy's prize destroyer was torpedoed NOT by Japan nor Germany nor USA. It just torpedoed itself. In 1974, HMS Trinidad was escorting a convoy of cargo ships when two German battleships attacked the last vessel in the convoy. HMS Trinidad with its good speed and superior guns, circled round to attack the two battleships while on the look out for enemy submarines. During this maneuver, somebody made a mistake in settling up the gyroscope of the torpedo they released to attack the German battleships. Net result was, the torpedo made a nice big circle around the two battleships and came back and hit the Trinidad. It made a big hole amidst the ship, but Trinidad managed to go to a port safely on its own. Ultimately Royal Navy decided to scrap it rather than get it repaired and use it again.
9. Amongst all wines, Burgundy wines are supposed to be the best, and Pinot Noir, a very special variety of grapes which grow in and around Burgundy are the best wine producing grapes. Burgundy is in France. Mona Lisa, painted by Leonardo de Vinci shows two defects in the woman pictured (Modonna Lisa). It is very difficult to catch them. One is and the other is, esotropia, a mild 'cross-eye'.

11. Although Hawaiian islands, small and big, are about 100 islands, eight of them are the larger ones ; and well habitated. They are : Hawaii, Kahoolawe, Kauai, Lanai, Maui, Molokai, Niihau, and Oahu. Do you know which of these islands has the capital, Honolulu ?
 12. Lake Superior with 2,728 miles of coast line and 31,700 square miles in area is the biggest.
 13. Alfred Hitchcock, directed and acted in many movies of his own, but never got the Oscar ; He directed some 50 movies, and acted in 30 of them.
 14. Sweeping out from the Alaska peninsula in a graceful 1,200 mile across northern Pacific, the Aleutian islands form the longest and most remote chain of islands in the world. Like Hawaiian islands, they have originated from volcanoes, and these islands belong to USA.
 15. When Tensing Norkey and Sir Edmund Hillary climbed for the first time Mt Everest on May 28th, 1953, they carried with them the flags of India, Nepal and Great Britain, and these were erected on the top. A UN emblem was also included.
